And GSIO was registered by Kurdistan NGOs Directorate under the license number (\(\frac{1}{2}\) - 134), which was issued on 26 March, 2013.

GSIO aims to define and raise public awareness by means of, Gender equality and the principles of human rights.

6-When campaign against gender-based violence project was implemented For displaced girls and women in ankawa and Shawes township on 1st February, 2016 till 31th December, 2016, we provided them with (22) trainings about (Psychological and Social counseling) along with (sewing and Hairdressing) trainings, five days for each training, there were (25) to (30) displaced women in each one. The total number of beneficiaries from (sewing and hairdressing) trainings was (550) IDP women, as for awareness sessions which was twice a month were (1251) displaced women, the sessions topic was about (Elimination of Violence against Women, Underage Marriage and Sexual Harassment and some other topics). This project was funded by UNFPA and Qandil Organization.

Project duration: 12 months. Note: The project was been implemented in four stages and was as following;

- 1-from 2nd February, 2016 till 1st April, 2016.
- 2-from 1st April, 2016 till 1st July, 2016.
- 3-from 1st July till 1st October, 2016.
- 4-1st October ,2016 till 31th December,2016.
